A BREAKDOWN OF THE DENTAL BENEFITS

Full Mouth Examination and Scale and Polish	Provides cover for a dental check-up and a scale and polish; a procedure carried out to remove excessive plaque and tartar build up on teeth.	Once per 6 month interval. 3 Month waiting period.	
Intraoral Radiographs	Dentists use x-rays to find cavities, abscesses, and pathology (disease) of the teeth and jawbone. X-rays show small cavities that would not be visible until they had become very large. This benefit covers x-rays for the mouth.	4 Films per member per year 3 Month waiting period.	
Emergency Examination	Provides cover for an unexpected visit to the dentist for sudden pain, a broken tooth, infection etc. Only the examination will be covered.	Unlimited 1 Month waiting period.	
Fillings	Fillings help to restore a tooth damaged by decay back to its normal function and shape, and helps prevent further decay by eliminating areas where bacteria can enter the tooth. This benefit only covers one filling per tooth in a 12 month period.	5 Restorations per member per year. 1 Restoration code per tooth number in a 12 month period. 3 Month waiting period.	
Extractions	This benefit covers the cost of removing teeth. If tooth decay or damage extends to the pulp, (the centre of the tooth containing nerves and blood vessels) bacteria in the mouth can enter the pulp, leading to infection.	7 Extractions per member per year. 3 Month waiting period.	
Impaction	Wisdom teeth are the last teeth to develop in the jaws; sometimes they emerge only partially above the gum line or emerge at an angle. Dentists refer to this as impaction and the wisdom teeth will need to be removed.	Maximum of 4 teeth per member per year. Applicable to wisdom teeth only. 3 Month waiting period.	
Root Canal	This benefit covers the treatment to repair and save a badly damaged or infected tooth. The procedure involves removing the damaged area of the tooth (the pulp), cleaning, disinfecting it and then filling and sealing it.	Maximum of 2 teeth per member per year. Includes Emergency Root Canal (1 Month waiting period). 3 Month waiting period.	
Crown	A crown is a tooth-shaped cap that is placed over the entire visible portion of the tooth. It's a permanent solution for a damaged tooth and once it's fixed in place, a crown will look, feel and function just like any other tooth. Crowns are usually needed if one has a damaged or weakened tooth that cannot be fixed with a filling. 1 crown per tooth number, per 5 (five) year period.	2 teeth Per member per year up to a maximum of R4 000 per tooth Pre-Authorisation is required. 3 Month waiting period	
Advanced Dentistry	Covers additional costs for dental procedures not listed above which can be performed by a dentist. There is a maximum Rand value amount.	R2 800 per policy per year. Pre-Authorisation is required. 3 Month waiting period	
Partial Plastic Dentures	A partial denture is attached to the teeth either side of a gap and replaces one or a few missing teeth, they are also used as an alternative to a bridge to fill gaps in the teeth. One set of partial dentures every 48 months per member.	Subject to Formulary. 3 Month waiting period.	
Infection Control	Covers protective equipment that the dentist uses during the consultation, like a surgical mask and gloves.	R2 800 per policy per year. Pre-Authorisation is required. 3 Month waiting period	
Teeth Whitening	Professional teeth whitening, once every 12 months, to lighten tooth colour and reduce surface stains and discolouration, improving the overall appearance of your smile. Over-the-counter medication and home- use kits are excluded.	R2 000 per policy per year Pre-authorisation is required. 3 month waiting period
